TJLA JUNIOR DIRECTOR
AWARD SYSTEM

JUNIOR DIRECTOR AWARD LEVELS:

WHITE LEVEL – 200 points (must reach this level by March 1st to meet deadline for jacket order)

This is the minimum level that all Junior Directors must reach to be considered active and to be considered for re-election the following year. Any junior director that has accumulated a minimum of **200** points at the end of the Fall Classic receives a specially designated Top Ten jacket that will set them apart from the rest of the membership. Although Junior Directors are elected from year to year Junior Directors that are in good standing that have reached the minimum 200 point level will not be required to re-apply the following year to be placed on the ballot, provided that the application packet does not change.

RED LEVEL – 250 points

At this level any junior director that accumulates **250** or more points will be awarded the white level award plus they will earn a Junior Director patch for their jacket. Junior Director patches may not be purchased as they have been in the past – they can only be earned by reaching 250 points.

BLUE LEVEL – 350 points

At the Blue level any junior director that accumulates **350** or more points will receive their awards from the white and red level plus they will be awarded a \$50 gift certificate to be used in the TJLA Online Store. In addition, Junior Directors accumulating 350 points AND attends the Belt Buckle Bonanza, Retreat, Fall Classic, their banquet and TJLA Camp in one election year will be automatically re-appointed to the Junior Board of Directors the following year if they so choose. Those Junior Directors that don't attend all five events may still be placed on the ballot for election purposes but only the Junior Directors that reach 350 AND attend these five events will be reappointed without being voted on by the membership.

PURPLE LEVEL – 1500 points

Beginning with the 2007-2008 year, Junior Directors have the opportunity to begin accumulating points over the years that they serve as a TJLA Junior Director. Junior Directors that accumulate **1500** points will be awarded a TJLA Ring. These points will be kept on a cumulative basis for the number of years it takes to reach this award level.

JUNIOR DIRECTOR RISING STAR ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This prestigious award will be reserved for graduating seniors that have served the TJLA Junior Director Board for a minimum of four (4) years and have reached all levels of Junior Director awards, provided that they have remained active and in good standing. These deserving young people will receive an award and a \$500 savings bond.
